### Mask Utilizations

The Transportation Security Administration (TSA) is extending the face mask requirement through January 18th, 2022. The mandate had originally been slated to expire on September 13th, 2021. However, this is no longer the case as the extension means that the mask requirement will apply to individuals across all transportation networks (buses, rail, aircraft, etc.) throughout the United States until next year. For additional information, personnel are encouraged to visit tsa.gov/coronavirus.

### COVID-19: Vaccination

At present, we recommend and encourage our drivers to be vaccinated, but we do not require it. Due to the nature of our service, some riders are requesting our personnel to be vaccinated, and we expect some of our contracts with brokers to require it in the coming weeks. As a company, we are evaluating options like having a pay differential if not vaccinated, as a way to have coverage for trips. But we do not require it for everyone. If changes happen regarding this communication or governmental mandates are posted, everyone in Medstar will be properly informed.

Starting on September 15th, there will be a \$20 bonus for each COVID+/take precautions transport (we are increasing it from \$10). If you are vaccinated, this is a great service and great pay when compared to EMTs or competitors' pay.
